Disney Trip - 2022 (Subject to Change)



Wednesday, March 23, 2022 (Travel Day)

- 2:00 p.m. Students/Chaperones/Directors arrive to DFW Airport (Allegiant Charter Flight)**
Flight # - 4001 Terminal – TBD Flight Departure: 4:00 p.m.
- **Dress Code: White Practice Shirt and Shorts/ Pants / Face Masks** (light jacket if needed)
 - Parents will accompany students to designated Terminal Ticket Counter Area with required ID, luggage and/ or carry-on Items, Instruments packed in luggage or larger instruments secured in cases, and **sack lunch (no liquids – purchase at the gate)**.
 - All students will check-in with assigned Chaperone/ Director before proceeding as a group to the ticket counter and security checkpoint.
 - Upon arrival at Sanford Airport, students and chaperones will collect luggage and instruments and board assigned charter buses in order to proceed to Pop Century Resort in Orlando (about a 55 minute ride).
 - Chaperones will conduct bus check-in procedures before departing the airport.
- 2:45 p.m. Students/Chaperones/Directors arrive to DFW Airport (American Flight)**
Flight #: 1669 Terminal – TBD Flight Departure: 4:45 p.m.
- **Dress Code: White Practice Shirt and Shorts/ Pants / Face Masks** (light jacket if needed)
 - Parents will accompany students to designated Terminal Ticket Counter Area with required ID, luggage and/ or carry-on Items, instruments packed in luggage, and **sack lunch (no liquids – purchase at the gate)**.
 - All students will check-in with assigned Chaperone/ Director before proceeding as a group to the ticket counter and security checkpoint.
 - Upon arrival at Orlando Airport, students and chaperones will collect luggage and board assigned charter buses in order to proceed to Pop Century Resort in Orlando (about a 30 minute ride).
 - Chaperones will conduct bus check-in procedures before departing the airport.

Arrival to Disney's Pop Century Resort

- Upon arrival, chaperones and students will remain on the bus and wait for dismissal instructions.
- Trip Coordinators will bring room keys / lanyards to the buses for distribution. The lanyards will contain the room key, Disney parks ticket, and meal cards. (Please do not lose these items!)
- Students may visit the on-site cafeteria until PM curfew check-in time, and then proceed to your room for the evening.

- Dinner on your own at the Resort Cafes or your sack lunch if not already eaten.
- **Students in Wind Symphony / Wind Ensemble and Assigned Percussion for the 7:00 a.m. workshop** – Please consider purchasing breakfast items at the café for the early morning call time on Thursday morning!
- **Student Safety Measures:** Students should NOT prop doors open to get ice or at any time when they leave the room. Students must take keys with them at all times and make sure that the resort room door is closed!
- **Only assigned student roommate groups may be in their own rooms.** Students are not allowed to enter other student rooms. Students may congregate in common areas before nightly check-ins if allowed by directors, and only if appropriate behavior is maintained. After 10:00 p.m., noise levels must be less to accommodate Disney guests.
- **Prep instruments for workshop day tomorrow and layout assigned clothes.** Students will need to unwrap and prep their instruments for the workshop tomorrow. (Keep bubble wrap for return flight.)

10:45 p.m. Nightly PM Check-in: Students must be in their rooms to stay for the evening.

- Chaperones will check-in all students, review the following day's schedules and attire, and make sure students have their gift cards and Disney ticket in their lanyards.
- Chaperones will tape and sign-off on resort rooms after check-in is completed.
- To lower the Murphy beds in the rooms, pull down on the handle on the wall. Bed will lower into position.

Thursday, March 24, 2022 (Hollywood Studios – Performance Day)

What to Wear and Prep:

- **Workshop Dress Code:** Band Polo Shirt / Black Golf Shorts / Tennis Shoes
- **Park Dress Code:** Green Practice Shirt and Shorts / Pants
- Sunscreen, water bottles, lanyards with room key, Disney ticket, meal cards, drawstring backpacks
- Prep instruments for performance.
- Wear/ take lanyards with you at all times outside of your room!
- Students must be in groups of a minimum of three students at the parks. **** Very important – if a student is unwilling or unable to ride a ride due to medical reasons or motion sickness issues, the student must go with the group in line for the ride, AND, may exit the ride line when it is time to board the ride. The student will then wait at the end of the ride for the group after the ride is completed.****
- Do not join groups of students from other schools.

- 5:15 a.m. Morning Check-in for Wind Ensemble / Wind Symphony and Assigned Percussion:**
- Chaperones will un-tape doors and check on Ensemble/ Symphony and Assigned Percussion students.
 - Students in these bands will need to eat a breakfast snack before heading to the designated bus area with their instruments.
- 6:00 a.m. Wind Ensemble / Wind Symphony with Assigned Percussion meet at bus area.**
- 7:00 a.m. Morning Check-in for Guard:**
- Chaperones will un-tape doors and send Guard students to breakfast at resort.
- 8:30 a.m. Guard meets at designated gondola area**
- Chaperones will check-in students and ride the gondola to Hollywood Studios.
 - Students will bring lanyards, water bottles, backpacks, sunscreen, Disney ticket and gift cards, and items needed for the day, etc.
 - Assigned Chaperones and Director: Mr. Thomas, Mrs. Lentz, Mrs. Pascal, and Ms. Rowe.
- 7:30 a.m. Morning Check-in for Green / White Bands and Assigned Percussion**
- Chaperones will un-tape any remaining doors and check on Green and White Bands and Assigned Percussion students.
 - Students will be sent to breakfast at the resort.
- 9:40 a.m. Green / White Bands and Assigned Percussion meet at bus area.**
- Students need to bring instruments for the workshop.
 - When the first group arrives back to the resort, some of the larger assigned instruments may need to be swapped. Students will be informed ahead of the trip which instruments will be shared.
- 9:50 a.m. Wind Ensemble / Wind Symphony and Assigned Percussion arrive back at resort.**
- Students who share instruments will swap instruments (if needed) with 2nd workshop group.
 - Students will take instruments to rooms first and then head to breakfast area.
- 11:00 a.m. Wind Ensemble / Wind Symphony and Assigned Percussion meet at gondola area.**
- Chaperones will check-in students and ride the gondola to Hollywood Studios.
 - Students will bring lanyards, water bottles, backpacks, sunscreen, and items needed for the day, etc.

- Students will take instruments to rooms first, restroom break, and prep to leave for the park.
- 1:45 p.m. Green / White Bands and Assigned Percussion meet at gondola area.**
- Chaperones will check-in students and ride the gondola to Hollywood Studios.
 - Students will bring lanyards, water bottles, backpacks, sunscreen, and items needed for the day, etc.

- 2:00 p.m. Guard Students Check-in: (Gertie the Dinosaur Area near Indiana Jones Show)**
- Guard students only must check in with Guard Chaperones (Lentz, Pascal, Rowe) from 2:00 – 2:30 p.m.
- 7:00 p.m. Evening Check-in: Galaxy's Edge (Star Wars) – At Rise of the Resistance Ride Entrance**
- Students must check-in with assigned chaperones in person from 7:00 – 7:30 pm.
 - Students who want to ride the Star Wars ride may get in line and stay until ride completion. Those who don't want to ride may choose another ride(s) that can be completed by departure time.
 - Students who choose to ride the Star Wars ride must stay in line with the group and chaperones, and wait until all band students have finished the ride before heading to the departure check-in location together as a group.
 - Failure to check-in during the designated time frame in person will result in disciplinary action.
- 9:15 p.m. Departure Check-in: Students meet at Gertie the Dinosaur by Indiana Jones show.**
- Students who did not ride the Star Wars ride with the group must meet at this time.
 - Students at the Star Wars ride will join the remaining students at the completion of their ride. Chaperones with this group will lead them back at the completion of the ride.
 - Students, Chaperones and Directors will leave the park together as a group to head to the gondola.
- 10:45 p.m. Nightly PM Check-in: Students must be in their rooms to stay for the evening.**
- Chaperones will hand out Universal tickets and gift cards, and go over the following day's schedule.
 - Chaperones will tape and sign-off on resort rooms.

Friday, March 25, 2022 (Universal Studios)

What to Wear and Prep:

- **Dress Code: Orange Band T-shirt and Shorts/ Pants**
- Sunscreen, water bottles, lanyards with room key, Universal ticket, meal gift card, drawstring backpacks
- Wear/ take lanyards with you at all times outside of your room!

- Chaperones un-tape doors and send students to breakfast. Take Disney gift card to pay for breakfast.

- Students must check-in with any chaperones in person at **Hogwarts Express Train Entrance in Islands of Adventure – OR – Revenge of the Mummy Ride (New York Section) in Universal Studios from 2:00 – 2:30 pm.**
- Failure to check-in during the designated time frame in person at one of the designated check-in locations will result in disciplinary action.

7:00 p.m. Evening Check-in at Universal Studios – ALL Students!

- Students must check-in with assigned chaperones in person at the Revenge of the Mummy Ride (New York Section) in Universal Studios from 7:00 – 7:30 pm.
- Students must stay in Universal Studios for the remainder of the evening.
- Failure to check-in during the designated time frame in person at one of the designated check-in locations will result in disciplinary action.

7:45 p.m. (Optional) – Students may watch the Mardi Gras Parade after evening check-in.

- Students meet at **Despicable Me – Minion Ride** (Universal Studios near the park entrance).

- Wear/ take lanyards with you at all times outside of your room!

6:45 a.m. Morning Check-in:

- Chaperones un-tape doors and send students to breakfast. Take Disney gift card to pay for breakfast.

8:15 a.m. Check-in at assigned buses in the designated meeting area.

- Bring lanyards, water bottles, Disney ticket and gift cards, and backpacks.

TBD Arrive to Magic Kingdom: Group Photo at Park Entry Train Station (picture spot)

2:00 p.m. Afternoon Check-in: Cinderella's Castle – Front Side

- Students must check-in with assigned chaperone in person from 2:00 – 2:30 pm.
- Failure to check-in during the designated time frame in person at the designated check-in location will result in disciplinary action.

5:00 p.m. Guard Workshop Check-in:

- Guard students meet in front of the Train Station (picture spot) at the front of the park to exit together as a group for the workshop location.

7:00 p.m. Evening Check-in: Cinderella's Castle – Front Side

- Students must check-in with assigned chaperone in person from 7:00 – 7:30 pm.
- Failure to check-in during the designated time frame in person at one of the designated check-in locations will result in disciplinary action.

TBD (Optional) – Watch fireworks show in front of Cinderella's Castle

10:00 p.m. Departure Check-in: In Front of the Train Station at the front of the park (picture spot)

- Students, Chaperones, and Directors will meet and depart the park together.
- Bus Check-in: Chaperones will check-in students on assigned charter buses to go back to resort.

11:00 p.m. Nightly PM Check-in: Students must be in their rooms to stay for the evening.

- Chaperones will tape and sign-off on resort rooms.
- Students pack and prepare instruments for travel on Sunday. Re-wrap instruments for flight.

Sunday, March 27, 2022 (Animal Kingdom and Departure Travel Day)

What to Wear and Prep:

- **Dress Code: Band Section Shirt or Dragon Shirt and Shorts / Pants.**
- Sunscreen, water bottles, lanyards with room key, Disney and Disney gift cards, drawstring backpacks
- Prep instruments for return flight (re-pack bubble wrap for return flight).
- Pack any souvenirs which contain liquids (like snow globes) in your checked luggage. If you need help securing the items, contact your chaperone for help.
- Wear/ take lanyards with you at all times outside of your room!

6:30 a.m. Morning Check-in:

- Chaperones un-tape doors and send students to breakfast. Take Disney gift card to pay for breakfast.

7:45 a.m. Room Check-out: Chaperones will check students out of resort rooms.

- Pack all luggage and personal items, including wall chargers, electronic cords.
- Place all towels in bathtub upon check-out and trash in trash cans.
- Students will turn in room keys to chaperones.

8:30 a.m. Check-in at assigned buses in the designated meeting area.

- **Students will board buses according to their flight status!! Double check the bus listings for correct assignments!**
- Bring lanyards, water bottles, instruments, luggage, carry-ons, and backpacks to put on buses.

9:15 a.m. Arrive to Animal Kingdom: Group Photo at The Tree of Life

3:50 p.m. Flight #1 (Allegiant Charter) Group: Meet at The Tree of Life to exit the park as a group.

- Chaperones will check-in students to return to the airport for the flight home.
- **Make sure you are not late for this departure time from the park!**

Students/Chaperones/Directors arrive to Orlando Airport - 7:25 p.m. departure Flight # 4002

- Chaperones will accompany students to designated Terminal Security with Student ID, Lanyard, 1 Checked Bag and/or 1 Carry-on Bag, 1 Personal Item, and 1 Instrument.
- Students must empty water bottles and not have other liquids over 3 oz. in their carry-on bags before entering security. (No snow globes or souvenirs allowed in backpacks or carry-ons that contain liquids. Those items must be packed in checked luggage.)
- All students will check-in with assigned Chaperone/ Director before proceeding as a group to security checkpoint.
- Students may purchase water or food items once they reach the gate area.

 - Students must empty water bottles and not have other liquids over 3 oz. in their carry-on bags before entering security. (No snow globes or souvenirs allowed in backpacks or carry-ons that contain liquids. Those items must be packed in checked luggage.)
 - All students will check-in with assigned Chaperone/ Director before proceeding as a group to security checkpoint.
 - Students may purchase water or food items once they reach the gate area.

- Parents check for assigned terminal and gate.

 - Students/ Parents must be sure they have been checked out by the chaperones before leaving the airport terminal.
